BE ATM-WISE



Only use secured ATMs, such as those in shopping centres or the CTICC complex.



Do not allow anyone to 'take' you to a ATM – fraudsters may attempt to take you to an ATM, do not allow anyone to take you to an ATM for any reason whatsoever.



You do not need a permit to walk in any of our streets. Should anyone approach you, be firm and indicate that you are not interested. Walk into a nearby store or hotel if necessary.



Do not accept help from anyone at an ATM. This includes uniformed personnel as Fraudsters may dress in uniform and approach you. Do not accept any assistance and walk away from the ATM if necessary.
